Two boys were seeing who could throw the furthest. Alex threw the ball 156 metres. Tim threw the ball 142 metres. What was the difference between the distance of their throws? Who won the competition?

A family sets off to drive 524 miles. After 267 miles, how much further do they still have to go?

Dad bought a tin of paint at £5.68. How much change does he get from £10.00?
